## DETAILS OF BOARDING

- Bookings will only be accepted on completion of the Official Application Form, which must be signed
  by the owner and returned to the Kennels with an initial deposit of £10.00.
   Full payment must be made on completion of boarding and before an animal may be
  collected/returned to its owner. Credit/Payment terms are not acceptable upon completion.
  Initial deposits are non-refundable but may be credited to future bookings at our
  discontion.
- All dogs must be inoculated against: Distemper, Hepatitis, Parvovirus, Parainfluenza and Leptospirosis. We also strongly recommend that they have had a kennel cough vaccination.
   All Cats must be inoculated against: Cat Flu and Feline Enteritis.

A current certificate of vaccination must be produced prior to commencement of boarding as proof of vaccination.

- 3. Individual attention given to each animal includes:
  - a) Feeding feed is included in the cost but in cases of special diets being necessary the owner may supply their own food or supplementary costs may apply if obtained by us.
  - b) All dogs and cats are cared for according to their temperament.
  - c) All dogs are exercised daily on and off lead in our enclosed indoor and outdoor play areas..
  - d) Medication (supplied) can be administered at the owners request for a supplementary cost.
- 4. Any veterinary fees incurred whilst in our care will be the responsibility of the owner. Whilst extreme care is taken at all times, no responsibility will be accepted for any animal once it has left our care. All pets are left entirely at their owners risk.
- 5. Every possible care and attention will be given to each animal. A Veterinary Surgeon is on site 6 days a week and on call when not on site. Veterinary care is available 24 hours a day. In the event of any pet needing to see a vet it will be seen and treated at the Practice on site or by our out of hours service. We may need to contact the pets usual Vet Practice for clinical history. Owners are liable for any vet fees on their return. Any particular requirements in this regard must be communicated to Reception staff prior to commencement of boarding.
- 6. Bedding, leads, toys, etc. should not normally be left at the kennels unless specifically requested by owners. We appreciate that a familiar scent can help appease a nervous pet or one not used to kennelling but no responsibility can be accepted for their safe return as staff are continuously monitoring and cleaning kennels and bedding is changed and laundered at least on a daily basis.
- 7. All dogs must be microchipped and wear a collar and identification tag (as is required by law). This should have the owners contact details on. If a dog arrives for commencement of boarding without these then we will provide them and the cost will be added to the final bill unless paid for at the time.
- 8. All animals should be collected on the date of completion as specified when booked. However, if an extension is required for a few days this will be in order providing the kennels are advised of this at commencement of boarding or during the pets stay.

If a pet is not collected and no communication is received within 21 days of the specified completion date, the animal will be disposed of by finding it a new home where possible, or otherwise.
